

What do you do if you are “missing a type” on your team?

Use *Z Style Problem Solving & Decision Making*

When solving difficult problems, it is important to study the issues from multiple perspectives. Perhaps your team is missing a strong “F” perspective or perhaps you are all S’s with few N’s to share their point of view. This does not need to limit your perspective—if you follow the steps below. Ask questions from each of the Four Functions viewpoints to gain perspectives that might not be represented in depth on your team.
