





# The Rise of Neo-tribalism & Group Think: Impacts on Societal Institutions



**Neotribalism:** a sociological concept which considers that humans have evolved to live in tribal society, as opposed to mass society, and thus will naturally form social networks constituting new tribes.



**Michel Maffesoli** is a French sociologist, first to use the term neotribalism in his 1988 book *The Time of the Tribes*. He predicted that as the culture and institutions of modernism declined, societies would embrace nostalgia and look to the organizational principles of the distant past for guidance, and that therefore the post-modern era would be the era of neotribalism.





- **Politically Disengaged:** young, low income, distrustful, detached, patriotic, conspiratorial


# The Hidden Tribes of America


The wings and their feelings towards various groups

B: Immigration nowadays is bad for America, costing the welfare system and using resources that could be spent on Americans.




# 2021 Political Typology



# Views of government's role and performance mostly are divided along partisan lines





## Democrats and Republicans More Ideologically Divided than in the Past

*Distribution of Democrats and Republicans on a 10-item scale of political values*




92% of Republicans are to the right of the median Democrat, and 94% of Democrats are to the left of the median Republican.





**Hillery's late-night report to Cabinet**  
**PLEA TO U.N.?**  
 By Our Political Correspondent  
 DR. HILLERY, Minister for External Affairs, will take the first steps this morning to ask the United Nations, directly and indirectly, to send a U.N. peace-keeping force to Northern Ireland soon. The Minister announced this last night at a meeting in Dublin from a meeting with Lord Chalfont in London, where his proposals for co-operation with British and Irish forces for the North were turned down.

The Hillery also said that he had asked for an early meeting with the British Prime Minister about the North and that he expected it would take place soon, depending on the situation in the North.

Dr. Hillery stressed that although the meeting was directed at times - he put his case continuously against the B Specials - and although Ireland was now "going it alone" to the U.N., there was no question of any breaking off relations between Ireland and Britain.

"Britain is absolutely convinced that the matter is an internal one and that they have the situation under control. I am not convinced that this is so and so we differ on the methods to achieve peace."

Dr. Hillery said that the fundamental issue in the North was the main cause of the unrest. He was convinced, however, that the British were thoroughly alerted on the North and were working hard on the problem.





# Leading in a Time of Neo-tribalism


- Avoid Litmus-test politics & policies: US vs. Them Scenarios
- Focus on the big picture / common ground
- Look for agreement on “Why”


